Our Zakat Where Most Needed Distribution Process

Zakat is a universal welfare system to support people who are most in need and vulnerable.

It ensures enough basic support so that one can live with dignity. Zakat helps save lives and rebuild communities.

At IDRF, we have an internal evaluation system to distribute donations that are allocated as **Zakat Where Most Needed.**

We consider this based on the current circumstances at the time of donation. IDRF follows this procedure:





We evaluate and assess needs with our local partners on the ground





We make sure to balance crisis management & sustainable development



We implement a project that serves immediate needs and builds for the future.



Through your trust and support, we collect Zakat.



We then allocate your donations to our Zakat approved projects





Your donations are delivered and received by our beneficiaries.

Palestine in Crisis

Since October 7, the Gaza Strip has been subjected to relentless bombardment, deprivation, and unthinkable atrocities. In the West Bank, families face violent raids, grief, and unemployment. Since October 2023, over 40,000 Palestinians have been killed in Gaza — nearly half of them children.

Over 2.2 million Palestinians have been confined to Rafah in the South of the Gaza Strip. Relentless bombardment, widespread electricity blackouts, along with severe food and water shortages, have led to an unprecedented crisis.

IDRF has been on the ground in Gaza, even prior to this crisis, and have been providing urgent relief every single day. Our team has been providing aid across the Gaza Strip. We are committed to reaching as many communities in need as possible.

Our emergency response in Gaza includes vital aid, such as **fresh produce**, **food parcels**, **daily hot meals**, **clean water supply** through water trucking and desalination plants, **hygiene and dignity kits**, and **psychosocial support for children**.

While there are currently restrictions on the entry of aid through the Rafah border, our team has been working tirelessly within Gaza for decades. In addition to our aid trucks, we are sourcing aid locally, which includes food from local farmers, hygiene kits, clean water, and more.

With the support of our donors and supporters, IDRF will continue to support the people of Gaza through this unprecedented crisis.

Emergency Food Boxes

Despite the challenges, we provided families across Gaza with food boxes throughout Ramadan. Each box contains non-perishable staples, enough to last a family at least 1 month.

Fresh Produce

With the support of our local farmers, IDRF has been sourcing nutritious fruits and vegetables to distribute among displaced families across Gaza.

Hot Meals

Fresh, nutritious meals have grown extremely rare in Gaza. It has become almost impossible to access meat, a key part of the Palestinian diet. You helped us bring daily hot meals to families in Gaza, throughout the month of Ramadan.

Clean Water Supply

Amidst acute water shortages, families have no water to drink, let alone wash their hands. IDRF has been distributing 80,000 to 100,000 litres of water daily to approximately 20,000 to 30,000 people in Gaza throughout Ramadan.

Hygiene Kits

Providing hygiene items and clothing is a fundamental component of maintaining basic human dignity, and preventing disease outbreaks under these circumstances. We have been distributing lifesaving hygiene and dignity kits since the onset of this crisis.

















Psychosocial Support for Children

The children of Gaza have been facing immense trauma unlike anything we have seen before, every single day. IDRF provides them with psychosocial support activities, classes, hot meals, clean water, and more, allowing them a brief respite in the midst of chaos.

Medical Support

In response to the escalating crisis, IDRF has intensified its efforts. Historically, we have been instrumental in the comprehensive medical training of doctors in the region. Tragically, the war has claimed the lives of over 300 medical professionals. In light of this, medical students, supported by IDRF, have stepped up, playing a critical role in sustaining healthcare services and preventing further loss of life.

IDRF is at the forefront of providing essential medical supplies. From consumables to vital medications, our contributions are bolstering the capacities of hospitals across Gaza

Serving Iftar in Masjid Al-Aqsa

In addition to the crisis in Gaza, Palestinians in the West Bank have been subject to violent raids, grief, and economic loss. Despite the challenges this year, we worked closely with our local partners in Jerusalem to distribute iftar meals to thousands of fasting families at Masjid Al-Aqsa, allowing them to break their fast with dignity.



A Mother's Story

Beyond the sheer brutality that Palestinians are being subject to, the horrors of starvation and disease are another battle altogether.

Majida is one of 2.2 million Palestinians who have been displaced across the Gaza Strip. For months, she has been living in deplorable conditions in Rafah with her family. The sheer indignity of her condition could not be put into words. No food, no clean water, and no nutrition.

With your support, we have been able to provide thousands of Palestinians like Majida with clean water, fresh produce, food parcels, and hygiene kits.

However, this is not nearly enough to combat the mounting crisis in Gaza. The people of Palestine require a steady stream of support in order to survive, and we urge you to stand by them in their time of need.

Afghanistan

After decades of conflict and violence, Afghanistan remains on the precipice of survival, with over 24 million people in dire need of humanitarian aid and nearly 16 million facing acute food insecurity.

Yemen

Yemen is currently in the midst of a severe food crisis — countless Yemenis don't know where their next meal will come from.



Bangladesh

Hunger in Bangladesh continues to soar, with close to 40 million people facing food insecurity today.

In addition to its susceptibility to climate disasters, Bangladesh also houses close to a million Rohingya refugees, who have been fleeing across the border from Myanmar. These compounding factors have led to an alarming hunger crisis in the region.

Your Ramadan contributions have helped us bring food boxes to thousands of families in Bangladesh, providing them with relief.

Pakistan

Pakistan is facing a severe food crisis, as the region continues to reel from catastrophic floods.

As a result, a widespread epidemic of malnutrition and hunger has engulfed the nation, presenting a daunting challenge that demands urgent attention and intervention.

The situation is particularly disheartening, considering that a staggering 44% of children under the age of 5 are afflicted with stunted growth as a direct consequence of malnutrition.

Thanks to your donations this Ramadan, our team in Pakistan delivered food packages to vulnerable families in need to last them the entire month.

Ramadan 2024 Impact

East Africa

The horn of Africa is in the grip of a dire food crisis caused by decades of conflict, devastation, and the most severe drought in four decades.

Insufficient funding for humanitarian aid is putting approximately 36 million people at risk of acute food insecurity. The crisis has reached a point where a famine warning has been issued for Somalia. IDRF's dedicated team responded to the dire situation in Sudan, Uganda, Kenya and Somalia by providing vital emergency food support to the most vulnerable communities affected by the devastating drought.

Sahel Africa


Persistent conflicts, climate change, and economic instability have created acute conditions in Sahel Africa, leading to an alarming food crisis.

Approximately 18 million people in Burkina Faso, Chad and Niger are grappling with food insecurity, unable to meet their basic nutritional needs. Distressingly, this crisis has led to an increase in acute malnutrition among young children, affecting over 7 million kids under the age of 5. Your generous donations have provided families in Sahel Africa with nutritious meals to break their fasts during the holy month of Ramadan.

Inaaya's Story

Inaaya, a widow, lived with her 4 children. Since her husband's sudden, tragic death last year, she struggled to support herself and her children.

Near the Somalia border, she faced acute food shortages and water scarcity, leaving her family with just one hot meal a day.

The burden weighed heavily on her, especially when she had to travel a 3 km distance for clean water, causing her to have pains in her body. Without financial support, she saw no hope for the future.

However, with the help of IDRF's Ramadan food distributions, she could provide meals for her family, alleviating some of her worries during the month.

Your donations have provided a lifeline for countless families like Inaaya's.



Water Assistance

Close to 4 billion people experience severe water scarcity for at least an entire month, every year.

An acute lack of access to clean water leaves countless families vulnerable to disease. As the climate crisis takes hold, with unprecedented droughts and flooding, water, sanitation and hygiene must be prioritized.

In response, IDRF has been providing access to clean water to thousands of families worldwide, safeguarding their well-being.

This Ramadan, through your donations, we were able to support 339,100 people, through water trucking.

Ramadan 2024 Impact

Chad

Chad is one of the most water-scarce countries in the world.

Less than 1 in 2 children in Chad has access to safe drinking water, and only 1 in 10 people has access to sanitation.

The mounting climate crisis has led to alarming rates of water scarcity in Chad, threatening the lives of many.

This Ramadan, with the help of our ongoing water trucking programs, we delivered clean water to thousands of families across Chad.

Somalia

About half of Somalia's population lacks access to clean water, and must travel long distances to collect it.

This impacts countless women in the region. Many of them face the possibility of sexual harassment and injury on their journeys, risking their safety for insufficient amounts of water, which is often contaminated.

Water trucking brings safe drinking water to the doorsteps of these women.

This Ramadan, you brought relief to thousands of Somalis in need of clean water.

Zakat Al-Fitr distribution in Gaza

For years, your Zakat Al-Fitr donations have empowered our long-term initiative, uplifting the lives of the underprivileged families residing in Gaza.

Every year, through our comprehensive approach, we'd uplift over 150 local farmers by providing them with training and rehabilitating their individually-owned farms.

By purchasing fresh produce and food items directly from these farmers, we're not only supporting them but also ensuring families have access to nourishing meals throughout the year, including during the holy month of Ramadan.


This Ramadan, however, was different.

Thousands of families received fresh food parcels containing fruits, vegetables and a source of protein.

Ramadan in Canada

Food Distributions

Households living below the poverty line and unhoused communities are particularly at risk to food insecurity.

To combat hunger in Canada, IDRF distributes hot meals to Canadians across the nation every Ramadan. In Montreal, we collaborated with **Grillados**, and hosted weekly Ramadan hot meal distributions to those in need across the city.

We extended our efforts to the Greater Toronto Area, collaborating with **Halal Meals TO** to distribute hot meals to vulnerable folks in Regent Park, Etobicoke, and across Toronto.

Emergency Kits Packing for Palestine

This Ramadan, many of you also volunteered with your loved ones, to help us put together emergency kits for families across Palestine.

With your support, we were able to pack and send over 2,500 family emergency kits to the Rafah border, aiding those in the West Bank and Gaza. Your efforts will directly contribute to alleviating the hardships faced by these communities.

Each kit includes toothbrushes and toothpaste, a pack of sustainably sourced soaps directly from impoverished women in Cambodia, a solar light, water filtration units, and buckets.
